Chaperone Expectations:

1. Chaperones should follow all local and state laws.
2. Chaperones should dress appropriately:
 - Chaperones should understand that students are continuously observing them.
 - Clothing choices should be in good taste, meaning appropriate coverage.
 - Attention should be paid to potentially offensive images or words on clothing.
 - Make sure you think about the weather!
3. A chaperone's conduct should positively represent Magna Vista Band at all times.
 - Please be mindful of disrespectful language.
 - Remember that your attitude influences the attitude of the students.
 - If there is a problem with a particular student, talk to them individually and notify Mr. Loman.
 - Be mindful of actions that are not allowed by the school system for chaperones and students.
 - Not allowed:
 - Tobacco products
 - E-cigarettes
 - Alcohol
 - Weapons (do not take out pocket knives)
 - Personal display of affection
4. A chaperone should be proactive. Think through the events of the day and be prepared to solve problems before they happen.
5. Chaperones are responsible for all students, all the time. Do not leave the group unless there is an emergency or need from Mr. Loman.
6. Chaperoning is an opportunity for great communication:
 - Get to know the students.
 - Get to know the other chaperones.
 - Get to know the director and staff.
7. Please communicate issues with Mr Loman first! We should be able to handle most issue inside the band. Mr. Loman will decide to involve administration if necessary.
8. Chaperones need to wear their badge at all times!
 - This protects you.
 - This protects the students.
